

4 General information

Important Information Concerning Your Pest Management Program · You must advise us of any pets or of any personal or family/staff allergies, or other concerns. · Any persons who are particularly sensitive, or who suffer from allergic reactions, should, as a matter of precaution, remain out of the premises for a period of 24 hours and not return until the premises have been fully ventilated. · You must remove or protect any people, animals, bird, or fish during the treatment period. · You must avoid contact with treated surfaces until the control agent has dried. · You must observe any verbal advice provided by our firm or our licensed operator at the time of treatment. **After The Treatment** · Many of the products used by us are strong repellents. It is not uncommon for pests to be flushed out after the treatment, for this reason you may see an increase in numbers. For all treatments it may take some time for control to be achieved. This may be a minimum of 3 weeks. During this time retreatment is not required. · Do not mop treated hard surfaces such as tiles and timber flooring for a period of 1 week after the treatment. Do not steam clean treated carpet areas for a period of 1 month after the treatment. · There is no need to clean out cupboards after the treatment. · Do not remove treated spider webbing from the exterior of your property for 1 month after the treatment. This allows time for the spiders to come into contact with products applied. **Payment Terms and Details of Free Service Period (FSP)** · Unless specific written arrangements have been provided the full service price shall be due and payable at the time of the initial treatment. · Any FSP shall be null and void unless all monies due and payable to us have been paid in full within the standard terms of business above. · Where a FSP has been provided then, upon notification by you, we agree to provide you with any remedial treatment(s) as we deem necessary to the nominated property for the pests originally treated. · This service will be AT NO COST TO YOU. The FSP applies to internal areas only. · If this document is not personally signed by the client the signatory warrants that they have the full authority to sign on the behalf of the client. **Treatment Details and Control Agents** · The proposed treatment only applies to the pest species named overleaf. The program does not provide protection against any other pest/s. · Only control agents approved by the Australian Pesticides & Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) and registered for use by the relevant state or Territory Registration Authority will be used. · While every care will be taken, this firm will not be held liable should staining of timbers, fabrics, wall coverings, floor coverings or any other articles occur. · **WARNING.** Where drilling and or cutting is required; no liability is accepted should damage result to concealed services such as power, gas, water, etc. You indemnify Us against any costs that may arise from such possible damages. Clear and accurate plans should be provided by you before we commence. · If during the course of the program it is found that structural or environmental conditions

prevent us performing any sections of the Management Program then the FREE Service Period or the cost of your investment may have to be reviewed. Any quotation is valid for 30 days from the state of issue. · You accept that this pest management program can be rendered ineffective if you fail to implement our recommended hygiene procedure, by making building alterations, or by the introduction of conducive or infested materials, Failure to provide full access to treat the property may also render the treatment ineffective. · We strongly recommended that you should arrange to have your property inspected for termite at least once every twelve (12) months and preferably every three (3) to six (6) months as recommended in the Australian Standards AS 3660. · No responsibility is accepted, or warranty implied, for any damage or consequential losses that may occur as the result of past, current or future pest activity.

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
